# A SMALL BUT HIGH-PERFORMING PERIPHERAL DEVICE FOR JOHANNESBURG (SOUTH AFRICA)





## WHERE:

**Johannesburg** is the largest city in South Africa. Founded in 1886 as a mining town, some call it *Jo'burg* or *Jozi*, while for the Nguni people it is *iGoli*, or the city of gold, as it developed with the arrival of European gold diggers. With five million inhabitants and 33 suburbs, the city extends for miles and it is the representation, both architecturally and otherwise, of the contradictions of a country with strong contrasts: from the elegant streets of middle-class homes to shanty towns in the outskirts. The city is a hive of activity, with fashionable restaurants, elegant shops, art galleries and theatres.

# THE REQUEST:

Immediately outside the city centre are some highly exclusive residential neighbourhoods, including Parktown, the oldest settlement home to the Green Lung of the city (Zoo Lake); Houghton with its elegant villas, including the one where Nelson Mandela lived; and finally Melville, the neighbourhood known for its many live music venues, restaurants and open-air cafés overlooking the elegant pedestrian precincts.

In these attractive residential areas is a private home where a DAB KPF pump was connected to two JoJo Slimline tanks for the collection of rainwater.

The peripheral centrifugal KPF pump is compact but capable to generate high head, and it is ideal for supplying water, the tending of small gardens, and emptying and filling tanks.
